



EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends of the Corner,

Our fiscal year began on a personal high note with my promotion from Chief Development Officer to Executive Director. Then, in our third quarter, we suffered the loss of a significant source of Medicaid reimbursement. With the board, we quickly launched the **Turning**

the Corner Campaign to help us offset this loss while we assessed the impact of this permanent funding reduction.

Thanks to you, our generous supporters, we finished the year in a strong financial position and were able to work through this funding challenge. We are grateful to the 740 individuals and foundations who supported our programs and services in 2017-2018 (including – and especially - the 19 who contributed to the Turning the Corner Campaign), helping us reach 4,648 teens, young adults, and their children with health services, education and outreach so they may learn how to make the right choices for good health.

Thank you for being on this journey to "turn the corner" with us this past year. We are already a different organization now than we were a year ago, thanks in many ways to your personal support and commitment to the health of our teens and young adults. We cannot overstate the impact you are having on the health and well-being of our young people and their children.

Who did we serve?

We served 1,630 patients for 6,508 visits





Patients served were 30% male, 67% female, and 12% transgender or non-binary

65% of our patients were ages 18-2519% of our patients were ages 12-17



16% of those in our care were children of our patients, **ages 0-11**

1,024 vaccinations

693 physicals



861 tests for sexually transmitted infections



593 pregnancy tests (55 were positive)








What did our patients need from the Corner?

What else did the Corner do to help teens & young people?

2,632 youth were reached through **Theatre Troupe** educational performances and workshops

386 youth were reached through **education and outreach programs** at community events and other events

Our Corner Store provided **6,835 pounds of food to 350 patients** - in addition to diapers, clothing, personal care products, and other needed items

We hosted seven interns from local universities, and trained **27 "Ambassador" peer educators**thanks to funding from the Community Foundation for Southeast Michigan,
Washtenaw County and the United Way of Washtenaw County
