

PROVIDING THE BEST CARE TO YOUTH WHO NEED IT MOST

My first year back at the Corner was an exciting time of growth for our team. As examples of some highlights, in 2015 we:

- Expanded our patient age range to 12 through 25 in line with best practice in adolescent and young adult medicine.
- Increased mental health services due to a 25% increase in visits. With grant support, we hired another clinical social worker and a behavioral health supervisor to meet the growing demand for mental health and substance use services.
- Provided health care off-site to young people staying in Ozone House's shelter. A Corner Nurse Practitioner goes to Ozone House weekly to provide health assessments, acute care and connect youth to Corner services.
- Supported healthy youth with our health coach, a full-time position providing one-on-one behavioral health counseling sessions, weekly trips to the Ypsilanti Farmer's Market, and free fitness and cooking classes for throughout the year.

As we celebrate the Corner's 35th anniversary year, I reflect on those who brought us where we are today. The Corner family is deeply saddened by the recent passing of Joan Chesler, our founding executive director. Joan was a champion of adolescent health and a mentor to me and countless others.

"The Corner was founded upon the belief that all youth have a right to high-quality, affordable health care. What started as a 'mom and pop shop' led by me and Dr. David Share has grown into an important community and statewide resource. So many people have enabled the Corner to thrive! ...I am very proud of the Corner's place in the community and its role in helping to improve the lives of our patients and their families." -Joan Chesler, PhD




PATIENT DEMOGRAPHICS




