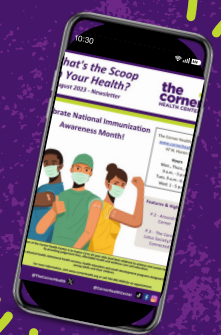

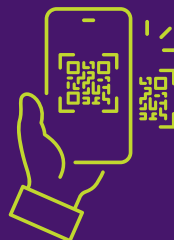

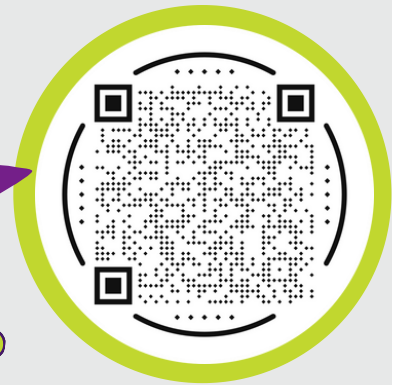

BE PREPARED FOR WINTER WEATHER

STAY SAFE INDOORS
 Keep an emergency kit at home and stock your pantry with food and water. Heat your home safely- do not turn on a stove for heat and keep space heaters away from flammable objects. Layer up with blankets and coats if the power goes out. Bring pets inside.

TRAVEL SAFELY
 Monitor road conditions and avoid travel if possible. Drive slowly and pull over if needed. Keep an emergency kit in your car and make sure your cell phone battery is charged.

USE CAUTION OUTDOORS
 Wear at least 3 layers outdoors and stay dry. Learn the signs of hypothermia and frost bite. Stay off the ice. Avoid exerting yourself and don't overdo it during outdoor chores.
